Accident Report

An accident occured upon the Duluth South Shore and Atlantic Railway at Ishpeming on the 20th day of May 1884 at 345 o'clock pm, caused by:

Breaking of a compromise draw bar, while making a coupling between an ore car and a box car. End of the bar flew up and struck Dennis Varduan, brakeman, breaking his collor bone and cutting his head. Was off duty for four weeks but is at work again.

Casaulties - One employe injured.
