It has not yet been decided whether the South Shore will maintain both the DSS&A and MH&O shops or not. For the present both are crowded with work. The MH&O after its purchase of the M&W had a surplus of motive power and as the M&W engines were new and more powerful than the MH&O engines they were largely used, the extra engines of the older road being placed in "ordinary" as they needed overhauling. All these engines are now being fitted out and as a consequence both shops are crowded with work.
