The staff of the <u>Nishnawbe News</u> has brought to my attention, a recent problem that has become a concern in the production of the paper. Galley proofs of copy material have not been available as agreed upon for the last issue as well as the current issue being produced. As you will recall, reference was rade in a memorandum to Bob McEachern from James Carter of the technical problems and time-lines that our student staff and the <u>Mining Journal</u> were mutually trying to address. Apparently part of the problem related to a question on the amount of copy material sent for the galley machine, and the unavailability of the proofs for our staff to sufficiently review and prepare layouts. Although the general layout of the last issue of <u>Nishnawbe News</u> looked good, our staff had to go to a six page issue necessitated by the changes due to a lack of completed galley proofs.

I gather that there has been and continues to be good cooperation with the Mining Journal staff in Mr. McEachern's department, as I've heard students comment on this from time to time.

We would appreciate your assistance in alleviating the problems with the copy material as I am aware that our staff has tried to abide by the agreed upon copy deadlines. I trust that our mutual efforts will contribute toward the continued quality production of the Nishnawbe News project.
