MONEY STATUS MOVES STOCKS

Heavy Selling Results From Variety of Causes. (By The Associated Press.) STOCK AVERAGES. Twenty Twenty-one

New York, Mar. 9.—Speculative uneasiness owing to the money situation growing out of the unusually high total of brokers' loans, the largest deficit in reserves shown in last Saturday's clearing house statement, and the increased demand for funds incidental to the approach of tax day and heavy governmental financing, was generally held responsible for the heavy selling of stocks in today's market.

Chicago, March 9.—There was another half cent advance in the butter market today, with the tone firm at the close. Buying interest, however, still continued active.

Federal Reserve Banking System Lauded By Banker In Address To Kiwanians

The federal reserve banking system is the very best system this country has ever had, and it should be maintained as an economic institution, rather than a "football of politics," Leslie French, cashier of the First National bank, told members of the Kiwanis club at their weekly meeting yesterday.

Mr. French sketched briefly the history and progress of banking in America, described the conditions which made the system necessary, and set forth the major features of the system.

Early Banking Methods. "Civilization," he said, "has a process of evolution, both in material and spiritual things. The history of the race seems to be a succession of experiments, failures, new trials and constant changes."

Banking Stabilized. "These institutions, usually called 'wild-cat' banks, have been wiped out, and in the evolution of our credit system the national banks were brought into being by an act of congress near the close of the Civil War, the title of the act being:

\$20 denominations so that the checks themselves could be used the same as currency, and a great many urgent subterfuges were disclosed whereby people had to have United States currency. Banks had to apply the notice rule on savings accounts which were under time contract or withdrawal, and a general shaking of confidence was the result.

Following 1907 there was a great deal of study of the question. One of the most prominent men interested in this gathering of information was Senator Nelson Aldrich, of Rhode Island, and while his name is not prominently associated with the Federal Reserve act, he did more than any one man to get it into shape.

Divorce From Wall Street. "As a result of this feeling that the financial power of the country should be divorced as much as possible from Wall Street, the Federal Reserve act provided that the United States should be divided into twelve districts in each of which a federal reserve bank should be established."

Member Banks' Benefits. The federal reserve bank, in return, gives its members certain rights and privileges, thereby providing the member banks with the outlet they need for sound assets and enables them to turn their loans into currency, as the federal reserve bank has the power of issuing currency.

Conditions Studied. "Our own C. & N. W. pay-roll checks at that time were made in

Practical Aid. "There was no currency panic and no credit panic during the war and I say to you that if it had not been for the Federal Reserve system, we would all have been working, but under its benign influence, vast governmental borrowings were handled as smoothly as any other financial ill the country suffered could be traced to the money markets. It is interesting to note that the same identical wall rose with reference to the Federal Reserve banks themselves."

Keep Politics Out. "There has been some effort in the past year to inject politics into the Federal Reserve board and, as mentioned before, some fault is found with the federal reserve system with reference to money rates, but it is far and away better than anything we ever had, its currency passing everywhere without question, that it is my earnest hope that it may be kept as an economic question and handled in that manner, rather than to become a football of politics, which would be disastrous to every person in the United States."
