

THIS INDENTURE, Made the 27th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

BETWEEN F. J. Wagner, Bishop of Marquette and Sault Ste. Marie and his Successors of the first part, and Township of Thompson, a Municipal Corporation of Schoolcraft County, Michigan, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, does by these presents, grant bargain, sell, remise, release, and forever QUIT-CLAIM unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, FOREVER, All that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the Township of Thompson in Schoolcraft County, and State of Michigan, known and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Number Eight (8) of Block Number Two (2) in the Village of Thompson, except that part of Lot Eight (8) of Block Two (2) of the Village of Thompson, Thompson Township, Schoolcraft County, Michigan, according to the recorded plat thereof lying Northwesterly of a line drawn 50 feet southeasterly of and parallel to the center line of US-2 as now surveyed, (which was heretofore released to the Michigan State Highway Department for highway purposes).

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said described property to the said party of the second part, and to its successors to the sole and only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, FOREVER.
