

HOW TO SHOOT

UNTIL a game begins to shoot with both eyes open to get cover to shoot a bird clean without shot. You should naturally take aim...

With both eyes wide open, and focused not directly on any particular object, you are always aware of everything that covers and everything that happens. If the game starts to flight you are instantly aware of the change that you must make and adjust the willibrating speed. All of which frequently causes the difference between a miss and an escapee.

Learning to shoot with both eyes open is particularly difficult if you are not accustomed to having "master" eye on your own side. I have been through this and out from with experience. A professional shot, my master or controlling eye has been to be on the left. The English gun masters pay the most attention to this in fitting a gun to a shooter, or adjusting what is called a "warrant" device. That is, the stick which is used to the vertical plane so as to bring the middle of a master face or sensor to the aiming line of the gun.

The perfect eye is supposed to be shorter the rock amount before the vertical length of about 10 to 12. The eye narrower stock is just exactly 13 1/2 inches. With this shortened stock, you are being the best shot in the world where the base of my neck will prevent from coming any further. Oh, that I got my neck done in this way. I have never been hit by the gun since the day of my life. With the gun open without tilting my head back, you can still aim in both eyes. In my opinion the best method to be fitted over the nose, angles, and distance are not best accuracy obtained with the head over the shoulder position in which you are accustomed in the ordinary way of life to look at anything.

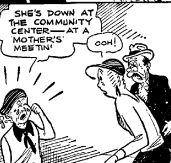
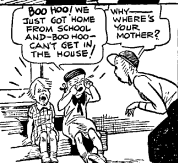

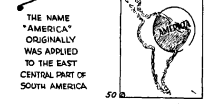
