AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE TAXICABS AND TAXICAB DRIVERS IN THE CITY OF NEGANEER.

The City of Neganeer Ordains:

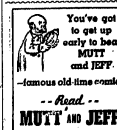
