Camp Montgomery near Corinth

June 30 /62

Dear Brother I will ~~will~~ write you a few lines to let you know where I am this evening that I am in is incamp in about two or three miles of Corinth it is the second division I dont no how many regiments there is here but there is a good lot of them there is one battery to each brigade I have not had a chance to see George Richardson yet I think he is with Buels army on towards Richmond I have wrote a letter to Catharine to say to let Josephine and Ella have a chance to come over to your house and Sallys half a day each week she says they are out of show if you will get them some and send me the bill I will send you the money as soon as I get the ~~xxxxx~~ bill I dont know what she will say to my letter I expect she will kick out of the traces as soon as she gets my letter

I should like to know how  
much her bill is amount at  
Feshons I am willing to pay what  
is necessary for groceries but no more  
for I calculate have some money  
left if I live to come home  
I wonder what is the matter with  
her she says that Doctor Phillips  
leaves her medicine now she did not  
tell me what was the matter with  
her I have wrote to whitneys folks  
and if she has any fancy Bony  
now I will try and find out and  
then I will know how to get in the  
premises I dont know she has treated  
my children since I have be gone  
away I have wrote her out a letter  
I expect she will think you have  
been telling me some tales if I out  
now ~~whether~~ whether she was true  
or false to me then I should  
know how to act but if she  
is virtuous then I have been to plain  
hated in my letter I wrote but  
I will soon know how the cat  
purrps you ~~would~~ not say any thing  
about what I have wrote we have

been sworn into pay so as to make  
the pay roll I cant say when we  
will get our pay but we want  
to be all ready whenever the pay  
master comes round Sharley is close  
by me cooking at the hospital he  
seems to enjoy himself very well  
I dont think of much more to  
say now I had a letter from  
Emily a few days ago she say as  
soon as I get home from the war  
she is coming home she has  
been knitting stockings for the soldi  
ers I want you should answer this  
as soon as you can direct your  
letter to Corinth Miss Comings
