here within few weeks

a going to stay here for
the present so if you send

now one knife & fork one
fine comb that I left behind
a few lbs of dried apples one
pail of fresh butter what

I dont want I can sell if you
w send me town your best
razor I might get \$1.25 for it
but about them chains I
guess you had better send
them to Charley if I was
sure of staying here. I
could speculate some but
everything is uncertain send
me about two or twelve
quires of letter paper
or envelopes I would have
some money but I am a fra
id of losing it in come
ing you send a letter the
day before so that I may
watch for it that hundr
ed dollars is few before
you get. This I want
you to let me know
about it if my express
comes right I will send

again soon and send
some more money, have
you payed any of them
debts I spoke to you ab
out good Bye
