me: Where at

me : who were your parents

Gil: My mother was Elizabeth WilFed Bomour

me: Where were they from

Gil: My dad was born in regunee my mother was born
in canada

me: ~~Well when did your~~ Family come to america

Gil: My mother born in canada but it's just that she destroyed their
they were on the trick and so she was in america practically all
Her life from being born and my dad was born there

me : Do you have any brothers and sisters?

girl : One brother living and one ^{brother and} dead Four sisters dead two and
Living there were 9 of us in the family

me : Where were you raised

girl : right here in this area

me : Did you ever move

girl : no we always lived in Early township or another

me : What did you do will you where grown up

girl : (pauses) besides going to school I worked mostly after I got
into high school doing carpenter work other I went threw high
school then college then I started teaching school in 1832

me : what kind of chores did you have around the house

girl : we had to take care of the poultry chickens we had chickens and turkeys
cattle we had to chase with cows talk in the wood shovel the snow

me : did you have any hobbies will you were a child

girl : hunting and Fishing ^{swimming} mostly mostly

me : Where did you go to elementary school

girl : I went to elementary school in diocese

me : do you have any funny stories about when you were in school

girl : I don't recall any, school was never funny there were strange things that happened but I don't but I don't recall any other

me : When did you graduate from high school

girl : 1931

me : Where did you go

girl : Ishpeming high school

me : Where did you go to college

girl : Northern in Marquette northern Michigan

girl : What did you do after college

me : I started teaching school at after going to college 1 year and 13 weeks then I started teaching school in 1932

girl : I started teaching school in 1932

me : How old were you when you got your first job

girl : 19

me : What subjects did you teach

girl : Well I started in one school I taught kindergarten three & grade and then I taught there for six years then I went and taught 5th and sixth grade for sometime then 7th and 8th grade before some time

me : Why did you want to become a teacher -

girl : Well my dad always worked in the mines

he always wanted us to get an education

and my he didn't want us to see us go to the mines

I had three sisters that worked in Jersey they did pretty well so

me : When did you become a principal

girl : About 1950 I was a part time principal

me : Why did you want to become a principal

g.i.: Well there were some things that I thought could help
to improve the school and it payed more money to

me : What school were you principal at

g.i.: first I was principal at double school till 1931 and then I am
transferred to north lake and then I was principal there from
1932 thru 1975

me : do you have any stories about when you were a principal or teacher

g.i.: Well (pauses) there were soneny things that happen^{ed}

sticks out now it been so long since I taught its been over 20
years since I taught school

me : When did you get married

g.i.: 1939

me : How old were you

g.i.: 26

me : How long have you been married now

g.i.: 50 years in october

me : do you have any children

g.i.: two sons

me : do they live in the area

g.i.: one amongst one lives in megan townships and he runs a wilderness gear
shop older brother live in denwood Texas however he is a fish
biologist for the city of Pg 41

me : when did you retire from being a principal

G.I : June 1975

me : What do you do now to keep your self occupied now that you are retired

G.I : There's always the work around the house mostly out to camp have a camp on Brack Lake we spend all our summers there then I like gardening I like fishing & like hunting

me : What are your plans for the future

G.I : Go on as long as I can

me : I am going to have to have your signature for you have given the school permission to publish this story if chosen and to be aware that nothing you said during the interview will not be used against you or to hurt your reputation in anyway and thank you for your cooperation and time
